

INTERNAL REGULATIONS OF CAMPING L'ORGATTE

The fact of staying on the campsite implies acceptance of the provisions of these regulations and the commitment to comply with them.

POLICE FORMALITIES : Anyone who has to stay at least one night in the campsite must first present their identity documents to the manager or his representative.

Minors unaccompanied by their parents are not admitted.

INSTALLATION : The tent or caravan and the related equipment must be set up at the location indicated, in accordance with the instructions given by the manager or his representative. Only one installation per location will be allowed.

RECEPTION DESK : The opening hours are displayed at the entrance. You will find at the reception desk all the information on the services of the campsite, information on the supply possibilities, sports facilities, tourist attractions in the area and various addresses that may be useful (doctors, hospital, nurses etc...).

A complaints book is available at reception and kept at the disposal of users. Complaints will only be taken into account if they are signed, dated and as precise as possible, reporting relatively recent facts.

FINANCIAL CONDITIONS - FEES: Camping services are billed according to the current rate displayed at the entrance and at the reception desk. The amount due will be established according to the number of nights. Payment of the price of the stay must be paid in full upon arrival at the campsite.

In the event of registration made as part of the reservation service, the payment terms specific to this service apply according to the conditions inserted in the reservation form. Tourist taxes instituted by the community of municipalities are not included in our rates. They are collected per day, and per person aged 18 and over, between April 1 and October 31, and paid with the payment of the stay. Our prices are inclusive of VAT

NOISE AND SILENCE : The users of the campsite are urged to avoid any noise and discussions which could disturb their neighbors. Sound devices should be adjusted accordingly. Door and trunk closures should be as discreet as possible. There must be total silence between 11 p.m. and 7 a.m.

ANIMALS :

In accordance with article 211-1 of the rural code and to the decrees and ministerial decrees of application, the dogs of 1^{er} and 2th category are forbidden.

Dogs and other animals must not be left free, or even locked up on the campsite, in the absence of their owners who are civilly responsible.

A maximum of 2 animals will be accepted per pitch.

VISITORS : After having been authorized by the manager or his representative, visitors may be admitted to the campsite under the responsibility of the campers who receive them. They must, without exception, present themselves at the reception upon arrival to register and pay the current rate. This fee is displayed at the entrance to the campsite and at the reception desk. If they want to spend the night, we ask you to declare them as an additional person at the reception desk.

VEHICLE TRAFFIC AND PARKING : On your arrival, park in the car park located at its entrance. Inside the campsite, vehicles must drive at a speed limited to 10 km / h. Traffic is prohibited between 11 p.m. and 7 a.m.

Only vehicles belonging to campers staying there may circulate on the campsite. Parking is only authorized on the site occupied by the tenant of the site. It is strictly forbidden to park on neighboring sites, nor to obstruct traffic in the aisles, nor to prevent the installation of new arrivals. The pitches and rentals have space for their vehicle. Any additional vehicle remains parked in the parking lot at the entrance at no extra charge.

MAINTENANCE AND APPEARANCE OF THE FACILITIES : Everyone is required to refrain from any action that could harm the cleanliness, hygiene and appearance of the campsite and its facilities, especially sanitary. It is forbidden to throw waste water on the ground or in the gutters. The "Caravanners" must empty their wastewater in the facilities provided for this purpose. Washing is strictly prohibited outside the bins provided for this purpose. The clothes line will be done discreetly and not disturbing the neighbors. Under no circumstances should wires be connected to the trees to serve as clotheslines. Plantations and floral decorations must be respected.

It is compulsory for the users of the campsite to put their garbage in garbage bags before throwing it in the garbage cans or containers located in the outdoor car park.

It is requested in the name of recycling to kindly sort the glass and plastic, no external personal garbage will be authorized on the personal site and this, for obvious reasons of hygiene.

Campers are prohibited from driving nails into trees, cutting branches or planting. It is also not allowed to delimit the site of an installation by personal means, nor to dig the ground. Any degradation committed to the vegetation, fences, land or facilities of the campsite will be the responsibility of its author.

The pitch, which will have been used during the stay, must be maintained in the condition in which the camper found it when entering the premises.

SECURITY :

Fire : The use of barbecues (wood, charcoal, gas, etc.) and fires on the ground are **FORBIDDEN** . The use of electric barbecues are tolerated. Stoves must be kept in good working order and not be used in hazardous conditions. In the event of a fire, immediately notify management and apply the safety instructions posted in the toilet blocks and at reception.

Fire extinguishers can be used if necessary. A first aid kit is located at the reception desk.

Liability, Theft : The general obligation of surveillance of the campsite is an obligation of means. The management is therefore not liable in the event of theft, loss or damage of any kind whatsoever, during or following a stay. Although security is provided, users of the campsite are invited to take the usual precautions to safeguard their equipment. The camper keeps the responsibility of its own installation and must notify the manager of the presence of any suspicious person. The management is responsible, during the stay, for objects left at the office. The campsite declines all responsibility in the event of falling trees, pine cones on equipment and vehicles. Please protect your property. . At the entrance of the establishment, the vaccination record **MUST** be presented. Category 1 and Category 2 dogs are prohibited.

GAMES : No violent or annoying game can be organized near the installations or in the playgrounds or sports areas.

DEAD GARAGE : It can only be left unoccupied equipment on the ground after agreement of the management and only at the indicated location.

There will be no garage during the months of July and August .

DISPLAY : These internal regulations are posted at the entrance to the campsite and at the reception desk. It is given to the customer at his request.

BREACH OF INTERNAL REGULATIONS : In the event that a resident disrupts the stay of other users or does not comply with the provisions of these internal regulations, the manager or his representative may, orally or in writing if he deems it necessary, give notice to the latter to cease troubles. In the event of a serious or repeated breach of the internal regulations and after formal notice by the manager to comply with them, the latter may terminate the contract resulting in the immediate departure of the resident without any compensation. In the event of a criminal offense, the manager may call on the police.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS :

In accordance with the regulations in force, the campsite Orgatte is a tourism establishment having for exclusive vocation the reception of the campers using, within the framework of their leisure and, on a temporary basis, a shelter of camping constituted by a tent, a caravan, a motorhome. Access to the site is therefore prohibited for any person using one of these shelters, either as permanent or long-term accommodation, or for the purpose of commercial activities. Likewise, users of the land are prohibited from engaging in any act of commerce and any commercial advertising on it.

Access is prohibited for street vendors, direct sellers, walkers, picnickers, non-campers.

It is forbidden to play ball in the alleys of the campsite because of the risk of fire that could result from it, unsettled satellite dishes, broken tiles ...

Washing of linen and dishes is prohibited after 9:30 p.m. and before 8 a.m.

Showers and sinks are closed after 10 p.m.

Children's games open at 9:30 a.m.

The campsite gates open at 7 a.m. and close at 11 p.m. on the 1st July to August 31.

Barbecues must be turned off at 9.45 p.m. - only electric barbecues are allowed

Stays made by reservation are payable on arrival.

Visitors present for more than 4 hours will have to pay the sum of 3.05 € per person payable at the campsite reception.
